Vendor represents and warrants that neither the performance nor the functioning of the product purchased under this purchase order, including but not limited to the ability of the product to function without interruption, to process data, or the ability to accept and respond to two-digit year-date input in so as to resolve any ambiguities, will be affected by dates prior to, during and after the year 2000.
